Automation Update:

For now the Library will connect through 687-4808. This will result in continuing phone line charges which were not expected with this project.

G. Redahl advised the Board that as a result of discussions with the City of Flin Flon, the development of policies and procedures are within the mandate of the Library Board .We are included in the Annual Meeting process of the City.

A Trustee Booklet as well was circulated (supplied by Public Library Service)- this booklet also supports the process of policy development. A section of Public Library Act was circulated as well.

Public Assistance for the InfoPod.

There will be a meeting(early evening) at the Library with representatives of the Federal/Provincial Business development staff to discuss the possibility of using the Library for a Canada/Manitoba Business Service Center. This Resource Center is a new initiative. There are 18 Centers currently being established within Manitoba - 2 libraries (Churchill and Flon) are included in these chosen locations.

The City of Flin Flon solicitor is investigating the incident of a patron of the Library who sustained a serious hip injury due to a fall on the sidewalk at the south east corner of the Library premises. The Board will be kept advised of the legal action the patron is taking.
