CHAIRMAN'S REPORT 2008

2008 has been another successful year for the Library.

We began the year with the usual financial challenges brought on by declining MB revenue due to Flin Flon's declining population.

These difficulties were overcome by soliciting additional funds from the sources: The City of Flin Flon, The Town of Creighton, and The Province of Saskatchewan.

We would still like to raise the wages to our loyal and dedicated staff but this year very little was done in that endeavour.

During the last 3 years the Library has collected mittens donated by the public and donated them to the Elks "Christmas Cheer Program", the Salvation Army and to The Lords Bounty Food Bank. In 2008 40 pairs of mittens were delivered to each of these three charities.

I would like to express the thanks of the board to the following:





Bunny Burke was recognized for 25 years of service on the Flin Flon Public Library Board.





ibraries are normally viewed as quiet, thoughtful places where people go to enrich their minds and get in touch with the world around them.

They're not usually veseen as battlegrounds, but that will change in very Flin Flon and The Pas couring the month of day.

The Flin Flon Public Library and The Pas Rugional Library will engage in the Fifth Annual Battle of the Books to see which facility can lend the most books and DVDs.

"Come to the library to check out as many, books in that one-month period (as you can)," urges local library administrator Phyllis

Stadnick says this year's competition has an added drama given that it is a tiebreaker event. Flin Flon and The Pas have each won two of the previous four challenges.

"In a couple of those years, it's been very, very close," she notes.

May's busiest library will treat patrons to a customer appreciation day. Staff from the losing library will be on hand to serve the hot

dogs and cake.
Stadnick says the competition is all in good fun and offers residents in both communities a great opportunity to see what their libraries have to offer.

The Battle of the Books was first held in 2003. It did not take place last year due to the reconstruction of Flin Flon's Main Street.
